Principal's Report (Kerri Bongle)

- Talent show is tomorrow night. Bongle will not be in attendance due to District office meeting. No max of attendance – anyone can attend. 4 teachers will be there to help
- Family Reading night with Ms. Carr on Thursday
- Friday is Way-To-Go party for this trimester (outside). Honor great behavior and minute to win it. Will include prizes for the Gator Golds. Rain date is Tues before Thanksgiving.
- If you are traveling, please let the school nurse know prior to.
- We are up in positive cases, it is linked to one bus route and LCHD is investigating.
- New precautions are going into effect at lunch moving them further away.
 Only Kindy and 2nd are in the lunchroom. 1st and 3rd is in the hallway.
 - Bongle with look for the bins they can use as tables.
 - Kids can start bringing in towels or mats.
- Moving students in the classroom if they don't mask properly.
- Avoiding mixing grades and classes. Instead aiming to do classroom presentations separate to avoid the close contacts.
- Working with bus drivers, CORE and champions to make sure masks are being worn properly.
- The "duck" masks cover the nose much better than standard masks.
- Why are there more Covid cases?
 - Asymptomatic + Symptomatic + Test to stay protocol. All mixtures.
 Email is going out this week to pause Shield Testing.
 - Corporate Care is willing to do the asymptomatic testing if parents have a need/request.

- If a student is fully vax they do not have quarantine or test to stay unless they are symptomatic. ICARES for medical professionals that the school nurse will have access to vaccinated students (who opted in).
